#### **REFLECTIONS** by Rev. Jane Tailby

Firstly, thank you to everyone who worked so hard for our Christmas celebrations in such difficult circumstances. Whether it was decorating, organizing services or events, singing in the choir, providing refreshments, whatever it is all so much appreciated! I am writing this in the middle of December, just as the omicron covid variant is taking hold and there is, once again, much uncertainty about what we can safely do to celebrate Christmas, so I hope that all the hard work has paid off, one way or another!

When you read this, Christmas, however you have been able to spend, it will be past, and we will all be wondering what the new year might bring. All the plans postponed from 2020, that had to be postponed again in 2021, will we be able to do them in 2022? Living with such uncertainty for so long, can be draining and hard to manage.

I am someone who loves languages, and so for me, it raises a small, if somewhat ironic, smile that the covid variants are labelled with Greek letters. Did we know that in the midst of all of this we are learning Greek? I suppose we can be grateful that they didn't go for Egyptian hieroglyphs (fellow fans of the TV quiz programme "Only Connect" will understand the reference here).

I learned New Testament Greek many years ago, and return to it now and again, although it isn't of that much use when trying to order coffee when on holiday in Greece! Omicron is one of two letters in the Geek alphabet for our letter "o". In New Testament Greek, omicron is used in the middle of a word and the other letter for "o" – omega – is used at the end of a word. The two letters are written differently in the Greek alphabet. Omicron, when it comes in the middle of a word is usually spoken with a short "o" sound and omega at the end of the word with a long "o" sound, which for me helps in the pronunciation of omicron with a short "o" at the beginning.

Omega might be a more familiar word to us. It is the last letter of the Greek alphabet (not "z" as in our alphabet) and hence it is sometimes used to indicate the last of something. In the Bible, in the book of Revelation, Alpha and Omega is a name given to the Lord, or to Jesus: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." (Revelation 22 verse 13, and also chapter 1, verse 8.) Alpha, of course, is the first letter of the Greek alphabet, so Alpha and Omega indicate the beginning and the end.

In Revelation, calling God Alpha and Omega is to indicate his eternal nature, and also that all things are held in him.

Thinking of God as Alpha and Omega is perhaps a helpful image as we begin a new year – God holds all things in his hands: the beginning of this new year, whatever we encounter in the middle, and he will be with us at the end of the year, and at all our endings.

Like the letter omicron, we may feel very small in face of so many challenges, whether it is the omicron variant or whatever else the year has in store for us, but we are held in the hands of the great Alpha and Omega, the Lord who loves us, cares for us and will be there for us at all times; the beginning, the middle, and the end.

May the Lord bless you and keep you through the year to come.

#### **WANSFORD PARISH COUNCIL**



On the 13th of December, all 7 councillors and 2 members of the public attended a General meeting of the Parish Council.

After the meeting, an apology for absence was received from our Peterborough City Councilor, Gavin Elsey, who had been held up in traffic on the A47 coming from Norwich. We are all going to have to get used to the idea of being held up by traffic on the A47, since we seem to be no nearer receiving answers from National Highways (formerly Highways England) to questions raised about the dualling of the A47 and the Western Roundabout at Wansford.

Those of you who had seen the Agenda might well be put off coming to a meeting by its length and formalised presentation, but we do try to cover all the items as quickly as possible. The five items of Planning Proposals were dealt with first, so that the members of the public who had an interest in a particular item could leave afterwards (unusually, we had no objections to any of the five).

Separately, on December 17th we held an Extraordinary Meeting to discuss Finance and the Budget for 2022/23.

#### The Village Street Scene:

The telephone kiosk is to be repainted in the Spring and we are again requesting leaflets to inform residents about the defibrillator within it.

Many of the road signs in the village are to replaced with more appropriate finger posts next month.

There is a proposal to plant a single "Platinum Jubilee" Oak tree on the green in Nene Close. but this requires further consultation with the residents.

We are to purchase another mobile vehicle activate speed sign to supplement the one which has just been moved from the Old North Road to Peterborough Road. Data from the VAS sign shows that it does have an effect in slowing traffic through the village and it is also providing data to help with our A47 discussions.

All residents are invited to contact us about any matters of concern. We always try to communicate with residents as efficiently as possible and are planning the revitalisation and update of our website to provide more general news for the village.

We hope that everybody can be fit, healthy and safe and enjoy 2022.


