NEWS FROM WANSFORD AND KINGS CLIFFE PRACTICE

BEHIND THE SCENES.....

In a doctor's surgery, the administrative staff plays a pivotal role in ensuring the smooth operation of the practice. The administrative team comprises individuals with diverse skills and responsibilities, all contributing to the efficient functioning of the practice. Let's delve deeper into the roles and responsibilities of administrative staff in a doctor's surgery:

Medical Secretaries: Medical secretaries provide vital administrative support to healthcare professionals. They are responsible for transcribing dictations, sending onward referrals to secondary care (hospitals, specialist clinics etc.) Attention to detail is crucial in their role to ensure accuracy in medical documentation. Most referrals are now sent electronically via an e-booking service. They monitor this system to ensure nothing is missed or delayed.

Accounts and insurance reports and claims: Billing and insurance specialists handle financial aspects of patient care. They process payments, prepare invoices, and submit insurance claims on behalf of patients. These staff members must stay updated on information governance rules and regulations to ensure compliance with insurance requirements. They often liaise with insurance companies and deal with reimbursement for medical services rendered (where applicable). They are often asked to provide information that is outside the scope of a GP practice to supply so time is spent explaining this to patients.

Health Information: In today's digital age, administrators play a vital role in managing electronic health records (EHRs). They handle all incoming mail (paper and electronic), scanning it to patient records and picking out any relevant information and actions needed. They send relevant information to the GP where appropriate. We handle on average 200 documents per day. This team are responsible for accurately inputting patient information, maintaining confidentiality of medical records, and ensuring data integrity and security. They also handle incoming notes from other practices (for newly registered patients) and ensure that all relevant data is present on electronic records. They deal with patients who leave us and ensure notes are transferred to a new surgery.

Prescription Clerks: This team process all requests for repeat prescriptions. We process on average 500 prescription requests per day. They can raise queries with the medical prescribing team to ensure requests are not delayed. They order specialist items and monitor deliveries.

Managers and Team Leaders: oversee the overall administrative operations of the doctor's surgery. They coordinate workflow among administrative staff, develop and implement office policies and procedures, and manage budgets and resources. Practice managers also handle human resources tasks such as recruiting, DBS checking, training, and evaluating administrative staff members. Their role is essential in fostering a cohesive and efficient work environment within the practice.

Overall, the administrative staff in a doctor's surgery play a crucial role in ensuring that

patients receive high-quality care in a wellorganised and efficient manner. Their dedication, attention to detail, and commitment to patient satisfaction contribute significantly to the success of the practice.







WANSFORD PARISH COUNCIL



Wansford Parish Council met on 8 May 2024, 5 councillors were present.

It is with deep regret that we must now report the sad news that our former Parish Clerk Mrs Marie Lewis has passed away.

Our Chairman Cllr John Stanage is still unable to attend due to illness.

Minutes of previous meeting approved.

Public Time One representative from the village came to describe how appallingly he was abused by motorists for trying to control the traffic over the Bridge, whilst the A1 was blocked on 5th of April. We thank him and his colleagues for their efforts.

Nene Close Parking WPC is continuing discussions with PCC to increase the residence parking spaces, the main problem seems to be funding. If more properties have off street spaces this would improve matters.

A47 Dualling Whilst Highways contractors have started to carry out preliminary works. We understand there are considerable delays to commencing the main works due to the excessive rain. Start for the main works is yet to be decided.

National Highways Designated Social Fund WPC are continuing to investigating whether this fund which is available due to the A47 improvements can be used for a noise reduction scheme near the flyover and the extra parking in Nene Close.

24/00210/MMFUL Continuation of landfilling operations

Cooks Hole Quarry and Thornhaugh Landfill Site, Thornhaugh

24/00378/HHFUL Single storey rear extension at 2 Peterborough Road Wansford

Accounts Planned expenditure was approved.

Peterborough Proposed Local plan PCC are in the process of revising the Local Plan for the whole city area and this has prompted Wansford Parish Council to think again about proposals to create a local neighbourhood plan working with adjoining councils. This requires a considerable amount of work over 2+ years but will allow the Parish Council to have greater power in planning future changes

Mick Grange from Sutton PC gave us an excellent description of the procedure.

Wansford Grade 1 Stone Bridge and HGV's WPC held a further multi-agency meeting online, and are hopeful that progress is being made to stop HGC's using the bridge. The favourite proposal is to provide width restriction with suitable signage.

Defibrillators The two new Defibrillators have been installed near the Robins Field and Thackers Close entrances.

Who can apply?


Groups with projects that are located within 10 miles of the King's Cliffe landfill site or the Thornhaugh landfill site may apply for grants. Priority will be given to applications received for projects located within 5 miles of Augean's Thornhaugh and King's Cliffe landfill sites.

What can you apply for?

Grants are available for capital improvement works to public amenity projects. Examples may include:



- - Nature reserves
- Village greens
- Community centres
 - Sports fields
- Public playgrounds
- Sports facilities
- Cycle paths
- Country parks



Projects must be available and open to the general public as defined by ENTRUST (the Landfill Communities Fund regulator), as a minimum, for 4 evenings a weeks, or 2 days a week, or 104 days a year.


